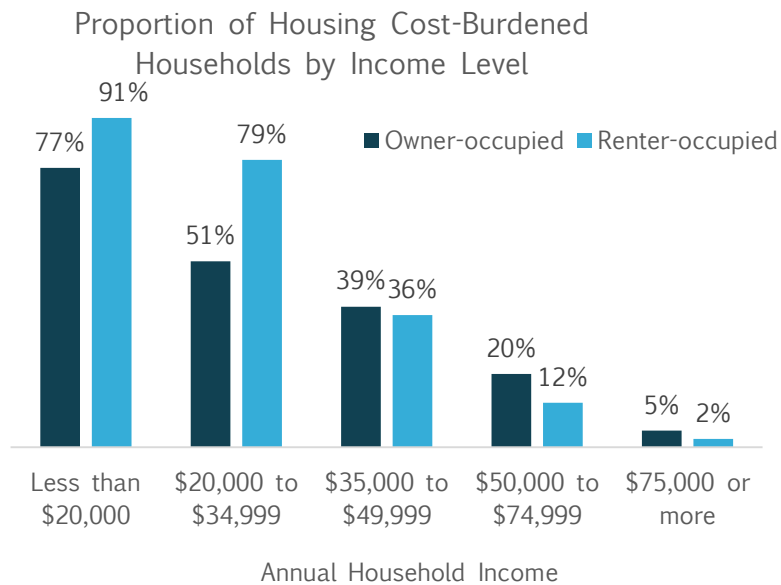


188,000 households are in need of affordable housing

Over 188,000 low- and moderate-income households in the Triangle J region are housing cost-burdened, paying more than 30% of their gross income towards housing. That's more than the total number of households in Durham and Johnston counties combined. **3 out of 5 cost-burdened households are renter households.**



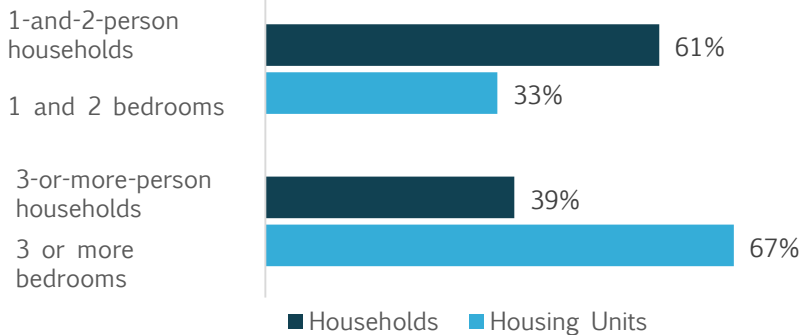
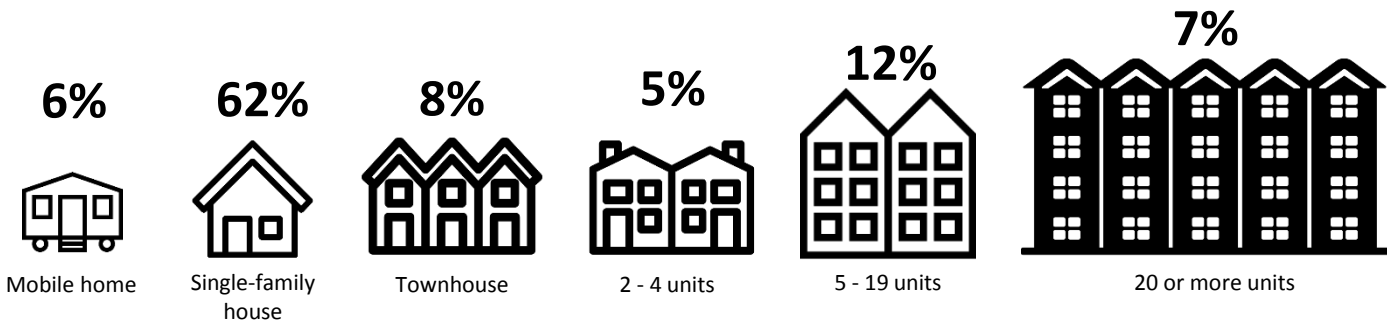

Housing Stock: There are almost **700,000** homes in the Triangle, **36%** of which are rented



61% of households are **1-and-2-person households**, yet just **one-third** of housing units are **1 and 2-bedroom units**. There are limited options for those who want smaller homes.
